

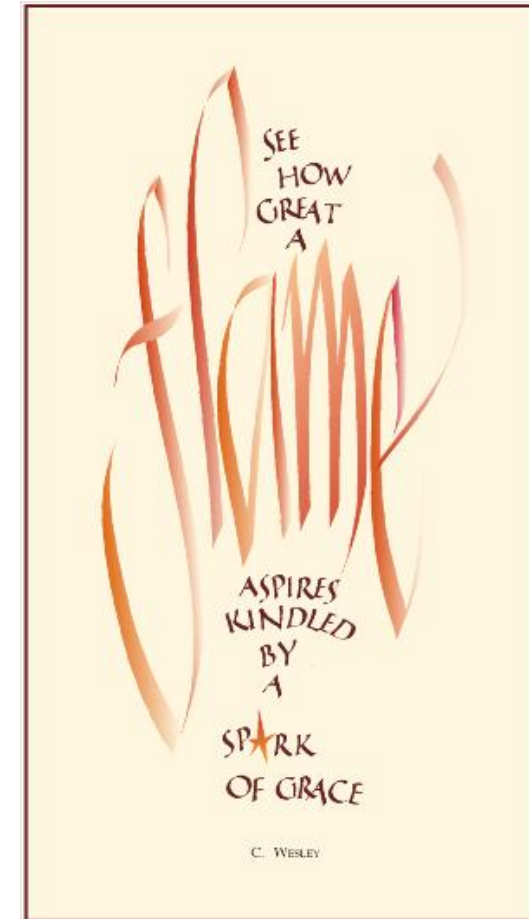
Dr. Ted A. Campbell is a speaker and an author of books, articles, and other works on Christian history, especially the history of Wesleyan and Methodist Christian communities and the history of ecumenical consensus in Christian teachings and practices. He serves as professor of church history at Southern Methodist University (SMU) in Dallas, Texas. He is an ordained elder of The United Methodist Church. Campbell's works, including nine books published under his own name, have been translated into Spanish, French, Chinese, Korean, and Portuguese. A former member of the Landmark Commission of the City of Dallas, he also writes occasionally on the local history of the Dallas area and on the history of his own family.
